Background Information

The Realtor of the Year Award is the greatest honor bestowed upon a Realtor by their peers at the local level. The award recognizes a Realtor for meritorious contributions to the advancement of their profession and the real estate community at large.

The purpose of the Award is to: recognize outstanding Realtor members of our Association for the effort and work expended in the interest of their fellow Realtors, their profession and the real estate community at large; demonstrate the outstanding work done by Realtors to the general public; identify those Realtors best suited for leadership positions; and foster a spirit of camaraderie among those who are in a position to do much of the productive work in the Lawrence County Board of Realtors.

Eligibility:

All LCBR Realtor members are eligible for nomination.

Application/Selection Procedure:

1. Nominations shall be submitted to LCBR. Members can nominate themselves or someone else.
2. The committee will review all nominations and make the final selection. Committee will be chaired by the previous year's recipient.
3. The award will be presented to the best-qualified candidate at the Installation Banquet in January.

Nomination Deadline

All nominations must be received by December 15th. Any application received after the deadline will be ineligible for consideration.
